

*Jones v. The Methodist Hospitals, Inc.*

A proposed settlement has been reached in a lawsuit entitled *Jones v. The Methodist Hospitals, Inc.*, 45C01-1911-CT-001201, pending in the Lake County Indiana Circuit Court.

***You may be entitled to receive benefits under this class action Settlement.***

*A state court authorized this notice. It is **not** a solicitation from a lawyer.*

The Lawsuit alleges that on or about March 13, 2019, through June 12, 2019, The Methodist Hospitals, Inc. (“Methodist”) was the victim of a cyberattack resulting in the disclosure of personal information and protected health information (the “Unauthorized Access”). Methodist maintains that it had meritorious defenses and was prepared to vigorously defend the Lawsuit. The Settlement is not an admission of wrongdoing or an indication that Methodist has violated any laws, but rather the resolution of disputed claims. Methodist encourages all persons who qualify as members of the Settlement Class to participate in the Settlement.

**Who Is Included?** Methodist’s records indicate you are included in the Settlement as a Settlement Class Member because your information may have been involved in the Unauthorized Access.

**What Benefits are Included in the Settlement?** The Settlement will provide Settlement Class Members the following benefits: (1) coverage under TransUnion Interactive’s *myTrueIdentity* credit monitoring and identity restoration services for an additional period of two years; and (2) up to an aggregate total of \$3,000 per Class Member for documented Economic Losses and \$300 per Class Member for lost time, up to a total amount of \$425,000 for all Class Members, for losses which are: (a) related to the Data Breach; (b) not reimbursable by TransUnion or another third party; (c) supported by required documentation; and (d) meet all requirements in the Reimbursement Form and the Settlement Agreement. **How Do I Receive Settlement Benefits?** To receive the TransUnion Settlement Offering, Settlement Class Members must submit an Election Form by

**October 6, 2022.** Details on how to submit an Election Form or file a claim for reimbursement are available at [JonesMHSettlement.com](http://JonesMHSettlement.com), by calling 855-604-1884, or by writing to P.O. Box 5768, Portland, OR 97228-5768.

**What Are My Options?** You can do nothing, submit an Election Form or a Reimbursement Form, or exclude yourself from the settlement. If you do nothing or submit an Election or Reimbursement Form, your rights will be affected. You will not be able to sue Methodist in a future lawsuit about the claims addressed in the settlement. If you exclude yourself, you will not receive the listed settlement benefits, but you will keep your right to sue Methodist in a separate lawsuit on the issues covered by the settlement. You must contact the Settlement Administrator by mail to exclude yourself. If you do not exclude yourself, you can object to the settlement, Class Counsel’s request for fees and expenses, or the Settlement Class Representatives’ requests for service awards. ***All Requests for Exclusion and Objections must be postmarked or filed in person by May 6, 2022.***

**Final Approval Hearing.** The Court will hold a Final Approval Hearing at 10:30 a.m., June 13, 2022. At the Hearing, the Court will consider whether the proposed settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate. The Court may consider Settlement Class Counsel’s request for attorneys’ fees and costs, and a service award to the Settlement Class Representatives. If there are objections, the Court will consider them. You or your attorney may ask to appear at the hearing, but you are not required to do so.
